

Dear Member/Village Hall User

After a recent review of the governance of the '100 club' operated by the Campton Village Hall Management Committee it was found that some minor improvements were needed to ensure full compliance with legal obligations. This opportunity has been used to make the scheme more accessible to the community by accepting payment by cash, cheque and standing order to make this simpler for subscribers to manage.

The Committee has therefore published updated information and costs ready for the new subscription cycle.

We hope that village residents will join the "100 Club" as a means of assisting, through their financial contribution, the provision and development of the facilities of the Village Hall for everyone's future enjoyment.

The basic features of the 100 Club are as follows:

- Lottery tickets will be sold as a bundle of 12 single entry tickets, to be entered into 12 consecutive draws from the start of the subscription year
- For a payment of £1.00 per draw, you will be allocated a Draw Number which will be entered into a monthly draw with fellow residents
- Example lottery income will be £1800 per year if 150 contributors take part
- A minimum of half of the total proceeds will be allocated as prizes
- Indicative prize sums based on 150 subscribers would be: (see notes 11&12 below)
  - 1<sup>st</sup> monthly prize £40 (26.6% of monthly draw)
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> monthly prize £30 (20% of monthly draw)
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> monthly prize £15 (10% of monthly draw)
- Additional subscribers will now be able to join during the year on a pro rata basis

Anyone can buy more than one set of entry tickets by simply purchasing additional bundles from the seller.

Please return the attached 100 CLUB LOTTERY REGISTRATION FORM to me as quickly as possible so that we can perform the administration in time to commence the first draw in May 2010.



100 CLUB LOTTERY RULES

The following will be the Club Lottery Rules:

1. The "100 Club" will be operated under The Gambling Act 2005, which deals with a Small Society Lottery. The promoter will be the Chairman, Campton Village Hall Management Committee.
2. The Village Hall Management Committee reserves the right to alter the Rules of the "100 Club" from time to time, as may be necessary. A copy of the current Rules will be available on our website: [www.camptonandchicksands.org.uk/villagehall.htm](http://www.camptonandchicksands.org.uk/villagehall.htm)
3. All profits made by the "100 Club" will be used to support the maintenance of the Village Hall.
4. The Lottery will generally be limited in membership to members who reside within the Campton and Chicksands parish boundary (but see also paragraph 12).
5. The subscription will be £1.00 per month, collected in a single payment of £12, by cash, cheque or standing order to be paid before the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May each year. On receipt of a single annual payment or a completed standing order form, the applicant will be allocated a Draw Number. For each additional annual payment of £12, an additional Draw Number will be allocated.
6. A draw will take place every month for cash prizes. Winners of prizes will be notified by post and the results of the draw will be open for inspection and published at the Campton Village Hall notice board and on the village website.
7. A minimum of 50% of the total annual subscriptions will be paid out in the form of cash prizes; for this purpose the "100 Club" year will run from 1<sup>st</sup> May to 30<sup>th</sup> April.
8. The draws will be conducted by 3 people, one of whom will be the Chairman of the Club (or in his/her absence the Treasurer).
9. No "100 Club" participant will be included in the draw if the appropriate subscription has not been received. The promoter reserves the right to reallocate any Draw Number where payment has not been received on time.
10. Prizes will be paid by cheque which will be sent through the post and only to the person holding the winning number.
11. In the event of there being less than 150 participants, prizes shall be awarded on a pro rata basis of the actual number of members at the time of the draw.
12. In the event of there being more than 150 applications to join the "100 Club", the Club will issue the required number of Draw Numbers to satisfy demand and prizes will be awarded on a pro rata basis of the actual number of members at the time of the draw.
13. Participants can cancel their entry in the Lottery at any time by giving one month's written notice to the Treasurer (and if paying by Standing Order, they should inform their bank). Any decision by Campton Village Hall Management Committee to wind up the "100 Club" will also be by one month's written notice. Under no circumstances can any payments be refunded.
