Waste Disposal

Household waste should be put in the Wheelie Bins and left on the boundary of your property. Currently these are emptied every Wednesday but from October will be emptied alternate weeks.

Green Bins or orange sacks are provided for recycling newspapers, magazines, telephone directories, yellow pages, thin card (not corrugated cardboard), plastic and tins (not bottles). Sacks should be tied. These will be collected fortnightly on the same day but in a different vehicle.

Green sacks are provided, for garden waste, these will also be collected fortnightly.
